**CALL UNITED TAXI WORKERS DISPATCH FOR IMMEDIATE SUPPORT**

Report harassment or a suspected "child-care vigilante" to dispatch. A trained taxi driver will be dispatched immediately to:

- Help de-escalate the situation
- Document the incident with photos or video for your protection
- Ask the agitator to leave and warn them of potential trespassing
- Record identifying details (license plate, clothing, etc.) to support any needed legal action

**REPORT TO LICENSING**

If you have been targeted, surveilled, or notice unwelcome visitors at your facility, once safe, please report the incident to the San Diego Licensing Office via phone at (619) 767-2200 or email.

Reporting ensures the incident is formally documented and helps protect you under licensing regulations.

**To file your report, follow these steps:**

- Download & complete the Incident Report Form LIC 624B at [qr.codes.pro/hf1emW](https://qr.codes.pro/hf1emW) or by **scanning the QR code on the right**
- Email the completed form to: [sdincidentreports@dss.ca.gov](mailto:sdincidentreports@dss.ca.gov)
  - CC your assigned licensing analyst in the email
- Attach any documentation showing compliance with required licensing procedures
